




Energy Charter Treaty Principles


- Promotion and protection of energy investments

- Dispute settlement rules











Balkan Corridor – affect of financial crisis

- Investment obstacles
 - ☐ Financial uncertainty
 - □ Cost of investments and profitability
- Risks influencing the expected profitability and therefore the decision to invest
 - Market risks (uncertainty on price and volume)
 - □ regulatory risk (impact of market rules and regulation)
 - political risk (uncertainty relating to international relations and often involvement of several transit regimes).
