



One Day Seminar «Prospects for CO₂ Capture and Storage in Greece»

The Institute of Energy for S.E. Europe is conducting a one day seminar on “CO₂ Capture and Storage in Greece”, on Thursday, December 17, in Kozani in Northern Greece. The seminar is being organized in cooperation with the Prefecture of Kozani. Kozani is situated in the heartland of Greece’s lignite and power producing area.

The scope of this highly specialized seminar is to review and present the various currently available options for the Capture and Storage of CO₂ both internationally and in Greece. As lignite (brown coal) constitutes Greece’s predominant fuel for power generation (more than 65% of electricity is generated from lignite), there is considerable interest to get acquainted with existing Carbon Capture and Storage Technologies (CCS) and the likely applications in Greece. Also, new CCS’s methods will be reviewed as these are now being developed by major international corporations. The seminar will be attended by senior executives, scientists and policy-makers from all the major Greek energy-related companies and organisations including PPC, and local authorities’ representatives.

The seminar will be held in the auditorium of the Kozani Prefecture in Kozani. It will start at 14:00 and will be completed by 20:00. A buffet dinner reception will follow. Participation in the seminar is by invitation only and is open to all IENE members. The seminar’s programme and a complimentary registration form for IENE members are attached.
