



16th National Conference «Energy & Development 2011»

Call for Papers

The Organizing and Scientific Committee of the 16th “Energy & Development” conference (November 22-23, 2011) announces a call for papers from independent researchers and energy professionals but also from research centres and companies. Researchers, academics, postgraduate students and company staff involved in the development and application of energy technologies may submit abstracts for papers under the general heading **“Innovative Energy Technologies Contributing to the Development of the Greek Economy”**. One special session of this year’s “Energy& Development” conference is devoted to the above subject.

This year’s “Call for Papers” follows the success of the 2010 Call, which generated considerable interest among scientists, researchers and postgraduate students, who presented their work on the development of innovative technological applications in the “Energy& Development 2010” conference.

Those interested in presenting their work in this year’s “16th Energy& Development” conference are kindly requested to submit electronically an abstract of up to 300 words by Monday, October 17, 2011 and send it to the following e-mail address at the Institute of Energy for SE Europe (IENE): info@iene.gr The title and the name(s) of the author(s) must clearly appear in the abstract followed by the affiliation of all authors along with the full address of their company or institution. The selection will be made by the Scientific Committee of the Conference and the outcome will be announced to the authors via e-mail by November 2, 2011. The full text of the papers will then have to be submitted to IENE the latest by November 18, 2011.

From the papers to be submitted a limited number will be selected for oral presentation at the 6th Session of the “Energy& Development 2011” Conference, in the afternoon of Wednesday, November 23, while others are to be presented in a Poster Session at the conference venue on the same day. The selection criteria will take into consideration, the content, the structure and the form of each paper. As far as the papers that will be presented in the Poster Session are concerned, the authors will be required to be present at the venue in order to personally present them to Conference delegates. Papers that will be accepted for both oral and poster presentation will be included in the Conference proceedings, as well as on the microsite that will be made available shortly after the close of “Energy & Development 2011” Conference.
